Clauses spéciales applicables au contrat-type des sixièmes programmes-cadres de RDT.

41. Application of average rates for costs by type of expenditure covered by the Community financial contribution to demonstration projects in priority 6.1 “Sustainable Energy Systems”

“The Community financial contribution for [those additional energy efficiency measures in buildings] [and] [the additional installed capacity of renewable energy sources and/or polygeneration] identified as such in Annex I to the contract, shall be determined on the basis of the amount(s) in [€ per m² built or refurbished] [and] [€ per kW installed] established in Annex I, Appendix [...] to the contract. This form of funding will be reviewed every two years by the Commission in order to be confirmed or amended.”*

* Up to the maximum amounts of average rates of Community financial participation by type of expenditure established in the table below:

Maximum eligible cost for buildings [€/m ² built or refurbished]	100
Maximum for installed capacity of renewable energy sources and polygeneration systems with the exception of photovoltaic systems and solar collectors) [€/kW installed]	1200
Maximum for photovoltaic systems [€/kW installed]	5500
Maximum for solar collectors €/m ² installed]	500
S per m ² = Energy saved (kwh/m ²) * cost of the energy * 15 years (S being the eligible cost)	

42. Limitation of transfer of budget between partners for the Specific call to promote the participation of partners from Targeted Third Countries (TTC).

“The Community financial contribution foreseen in the table of indicative breakdown of eligible costs and EC contribution (Form A3.1) in Annex I for the new contractor(s) from Targeted Third Countries, added pursuant to the specific calls FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-1, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-3, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-4, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-5, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-6-1, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-6-2, FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-6-3 and FP6-2006-TTC-TU-Priority-7, cannot be transferred to the other contractors without the prior written approval of the Commission.”
